

EARLY CHILDHOOD:

On the St. Joseph Campus, Early Childhood students are introduced to the joy of learning and are encouraged to develop in both confidence and curiosity as budding students. This early academic experience is marked by friendship, learning and growth. A seasoned team provides for the educational, emotional and moral development of students through thoughtful, creative teaching strategies and developmentally appropriate learning experiences. Teachers are dedicated to the development of the “Whole Child” through hands-on learning and exploration, developmentally appropriate religious lessons and services, “specials” classes including Spanish, Music, Yoga and Storytime/Library, and guidance from our Early Support Team.

Classroom activities are differentiated to the needs of each individual child based on their unique developmental levels and abilities. Little ones emerge from the St. Joseph Early Childhood program as joyful, curious, and faith-filled learners equipped with the tools and confidence to excel in Kindergarten and beyond.

ON THE SFX CAMPUS, LOVING CHALLENGE AND INCREASED OPPORTUNITY FOR DIFFERENTIATION IS A CORE COMPONENT OF CLASSROOM LEARNING. READING AND MATH DIFFERENTIATION IS SUPPORTED ACROSS ALL GRADE LEVELS.

ELEMENTARY:

Elementary teachers in K-4 encourage personal responsibility, accountability, and a service-minded view of the world and our place in it. The math curriculum, supported by the Houghton Mifflin Elementary Series, offers research-based approaches to support a range of learning aptitudes. Language arts is taught using a carefully selected guided reading program through the fourth grade to ensure that students are provided with ample opportunities to master reading with comprehension.

MIDDLE SCHOOL:

The middle school team strives to prepare students for the rigors of high school by creating a “safe” place to take risks, make mistakes and learn from them, and identify opportunities to lead. Seventh and eighth graders who qualify are invited to enroll locally in an honors tracking for math, or alternately in a Loyola Academy talented math program that meets each morning on Loyola’s campus. Google Classroom manages grading and assignments in grades 4-8, and collaborative G-Suite tools offer teachers and students flexible and sophisticated resources in preparation for high school. Middle school students also log a sequence of community service hours over the course of each academic year to nurture future service-minded servant leaders.

TESTING:

Standardized testing is directed through the Archdiocese of Chicago. Beginning with the 2021-2022 academic year, Archdiocesan schools moved to the iReady diagnostic for its ability to assess and adapt to the needs of individual learners. i-Ready matches the difficulty of test questions to the ability of each student allowing our team to measure individual growth over time.


Dear Friends,
