All class offerings are dependent upon a minimum level of enrollment. Any questions regarding tuition and fees should be directed to the Principal, Michael Kendrick. Other program notes listed below:

- Non-Parishioner Family Fee:** A \$250 non-parishioner family fee for families enrolled in early childhood programs which will be waived if your family joins St. Joseph Parish and contributes regularly.
- Tuition:** Tuition is remitted to Smart Tuition. Tuition is divided into the 10 monthly payments, or may also be made in one lump sum, two semi-annual payments or quarterly. Forms to choose the desired frequency of payment will be sent to you at a later date. Current families with no changes will not need to fill out a new form.
- Multi-Child Discount:** Families with students enrolled in grades 1 through 8 are entitled to a \$400 per child discount for each child enrolled in the Two Year Old or Early Childhood programs.
- Half Day Lunch Bunch:** Lunch-bunch Program can be included with a pick up time of 1:00 p.m. for \$470 for three days per week, \$620 for four days per week and \$780 for five days per week added on to the yearly total tuition.
- Registration Fee:** \$175 per child and is NONREFUNDABLE unless the school is unable to make placement. The discounted registration fee for families who enroll during the open enrollment period is \$125 per child (January 28, 2018 - February 23, 2018). The registration fee for families who enroll after open enrollment will be \$175 per child. Registration fees are capped at \$525 for families with four or more children (\$375 if registered during open enrollment).
- Change Fee:** There will be a \$50 fee imposed for change in scheduling between Early Childhood Programs.

Non-Parishioner Family Fee:

A \$1,000 non-parishioner family fee for families enrolled in K-8 programs which will be waived if your family joins St. Joseph Parish and contributes at least \$750 per year to the parish.

Tuition:

Tuition is remitted to Smart Tuition. Tuition is divided into the 10 monthly payments, or may also be made in one lump sum, two semi-annual payments or quarterly. Forms to choose the desired frequency of payment will be sent to you at a later date. Current families with no changes will not need to fill out a new form.

Technology Fee:

There is a technology fee of \$250. This fee will not increase for the foreseeable future and will be used to fund the continuous maintenance and updating of our technological resources.

Registration Fee:

\$175 per child and is NONREFUNDABLE unless the school is unable to make placement. The discounted registration fee for families who enroll during the open enrollment period is \$125 per child (January 28, 2018 - February 23, 2018). The registration fee for families who enroll after open enrollment will be \$175 per child. Registration fees are capped at \$525 for families with four or more children (\$375 if registered during open enrollment).
